WHICH WAY DO I GO?

When exiting Lucerne Lakes Community by vehicle, you may not realize Lucerne Lakes Blvd. has designated directional markings. Make sure you follow the markings on the road.



The right lane is to be used for right turns <u>only</u>.



The left lane is to be used for left turns and straight through to the bank.



Be aware of oncoming traffic as you pull onto Lake Worth Road. Look for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Lastly, always drive defensively; your life may depend on it.
