PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

National elections are over. Consequently, we are only receiving 10 pieces of advertising each day in the mail. Maybe it's just my imagination.

The November Board meeting agenda included:

- The proposed 2019 budget (HOA and Swim Club) as sent to all homeowners was approved. Quarterly payment booklets should be in the mail in December. Make sure if you do NOT have a local mailing address, GRS is notified as soon as possible. Remember to update your autopay with the new dues amount.
- The Board reviewed two proposals to make repairs to the Clubhouse roof. The Board chose the proposal from Van Guard Hammer for \$3,550.
- The Board will now consider implementing deferred facility projects as proposed by our Reserve Fund Study. Both the HOA and Swim Club reserve funds have adequate funds for the proposed projects.
- Both the parking lot light and the night swimming issues are in the county permitting process. We hope to see action on both, soon.
- Anyone who asked to delay their violation completion until John Docherty's return, will have until December 7, 2018 to secure a project date with John. Please let GRS know the timeline for your project. If you don't contact GRS by December 7th, the violation will continue.
- The pool hours remain dawn to dusk until we are certified for night swimming.
- The Board discussed the tennis facility and its limited use. In hopes to spur more activity at this facility, the Board voted to paint two pickleball courts on ONE of the tennis courts. More information will be coming when the courts are ready (see the related article in this newsletter for more info about pickleball).

PICKLEBALL IS COMING TO LUCERNE LAKES SOUTH

At the November 14, 2018 meeting, the Lucerne Lakes, South HOA Board approved the overlay of pickleball lines onto one of the tennis courts. Please note; the tennis courts will still be able to be used for tennis. In addition, portable pickleball nets will be purchased. In a short while, you will be able to play pickleball and/or tennis.

Pickleball is a paddle sport (similar to a racquet sport that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis. Two or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a wiffle ball, over a net. The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules somewhat similar to tennis, with several modifications. It is a great sport for "older" folks as there is not as much movement involved as tennis. A demonstration will be held for all interested residents once the courts have been lined.


