President's Message

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

If you weren't able to attend our February HOA Board Meeting, here are a few of the issues we covered:

- The sink hole that was discovered after Hurricane Irma is now filled. We are continuing to study our storm water drainage system as a result of the hole.
- Our Comcast contract that was signed a few years ago by a previous Board Chairman is still being examined.
- The HOA Board Attorney, Larry Cortez, explained three board of director openings were filled at our annual meeting in January, according to our bylaws. He further explained the options to filling the two remaining positions. The Board received two applications of volunteers who were willing to fill the open positions. The applications were considered and the Board voted to <u>not</u> fill the two vacant positions per the Board's prerogative and per the guidelines as explained by the Attorney.
- The history and electrical usage of the east parking lot light on Pine Forest Circle was explained. The Board voted to disconnect the light from the resident's service and connect to an HOA owned panel.
- Issues to be discussed at future meetings include: a Reserve Fund analysis, replacing Clubhouse keys with fobs, reducing the HOA Board size, and updating our HOA documents.



How do I Properly Dispose of My Old American Flag?*

Palm Beach County residents may bring old U.S. flags to any of the Home Chemical and Recycling Centers for proper, honorable disposal. Centers are located in Lantana, Delray Beach, and Jupiter; to name a few.

If a flag is torn, it can be repaired, preferable by a professional or someone skilled in mending. If it is dirty, it can be washed, preferably by hand with a mild soap. If it is faded or tattered beyond repair, or dirty beyond cleaning, then it is time to replace the flag.

Many Veterans organizations hold special ceremonies to dispose of unserviceable flags or have collection points for unserviceable flags. Find out more about these ceremonies by researching the American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars.

In addition, the local Boy Scouts of America may offer unserviceable flag guidance and may hold collection events.
