Beware! Computer Scams are Everywhere!

Have you received an unsolicited phone call about your personal computer (PC) from people claiming to be from Microsoft? They may further claim that your PC is sending out viruses OR they may say your computer is emitting strange signals to the their computer. The caller may tell you they need to access your computer remotely. This request should send up red flags! Do NOT allow the caller to access your computer! Microsoft NEVER calls customers on the phone! You should NEVER let anyone you do not know access your PC remotely, no matter what. If an outside source accesses your PC remotely, they may put viruses on your computer and then charge you to remove them. They will explain the viruses already exist, when in fact, the outside source was the entity that installed the viruses.

If you get one of these calls, turn off your computer by pressing and holding the power button down. Hang up on the caller. These calls are random and can happen often. Don't get scammed.
