Here is the news from our April Meeting:

- 1. We had an unexpected visit by representatives of Mattamy Homes. Highlights were that the next submission of plans will be given to the county in May. There will be 450 units, one and two story single family homes and two story townhouses. The prices will range from \$290,000 to \$500,000 which will increase our values. There will be public hearings before the county approval. Homeowners will receive registered letters notifying them of the date and time of said meetings. - 2. We discussed and approved contracts for shutters at the clubhouse, painting of the fences along Lucerne Lakes Boulevard, the pool area and the parking lots, and repairs and asphalt overlay of our walkways.
- 3. We discussed the Comcast installation of fiberoptic lines and other minor problems; red ant hills at the clubhouse, damage from the storm on April 11, and the pool deck repair.
