If your service falls on one of these holidays, your items will be collected on the next scheduled service day. There is no make-up collection day on these holidays.

Plan for Reporting Street Light Outages


Due to problems with street lights not working, the Master Association has instituted a plan to simplify reporting outages so that repairs can be made in a timelier manner.

As of February 29, 2016, all reports of street light outages on MASTER ASSOCIATION ROADS, should be reported directly to Association Vice-President Joel Duberstein, either by phone at 561-963-4377 or e-mail at joelduber@aol.com. He will then notify FPL.

All reported outages must include 1) the pole number, 2) the name of the person reporting the outage, and 3) the phone number of the person reporting the outage.

All residents must be aware of the following:

- All light poles that the Master Association is responsible for will have a painted number on the pole. On poles with 2 lights, one side has a black number and the other has a red number. When reporting, please state the color and number of the pole.
- FPL gives a 7 to 14 day response time for repairs, after reporting.
- FPL will not be called for 1 or 2 lights being out, unless they are on the same pole.
- FPL will be called when several outages are reported.




LABOR DAY PARTY
