# **President's Message**

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Let me bring you up to date with some HOA happenings:

- To clarify last month's president's message regarding the vacant director's position, the Board voted not to fill the two vacant positions by a vote of 4-3 vote,
- The Board is waiting for two more proposals to reconnect the East Parking Lot light to an HOA panel rather than a private homeowner's panel,
- The Board voted to go to arbitration to resolve our conflict with the Comcast eight-year contract (we are disputing that the terms of the signed contract are higher than what was negotiated),
- The Board will sit down with two key fob companies and learn how they can help us; the fobs would replace the keys used for access to the clubhouse, pool and tennis court, and
- The Board voted to recommend starting the process to change the By-laws to reduce the number of HOA Board members from nine to seven; more information will be available in the near future.

- Please contact the Architecture Committee if you are painting, roofing, doing driveway upgrades or any outside work on your home,
- The Entertainment Committee is trying some new ideas; give these new events a try, and
- The <u>Master HOA</u> Board had a full complement of members attending the March <u>Master</u> meeting for the first time in many years; the Master Board is forming a committee to make recommendations to improve Lucerne Lakes Blvd.




### St. Patrick's Day Dinner – A Huge Success
