## AMENDMENTS TO THE DECLARATION OF CONDOMINIUM OF

## ALBANESE COMMERCE CENTER, A CONDOMINIUM (A Non-profit Corporation of Florida)

(additions indicated by underlining, deletions by "----", and unaffected language by ". . . ")

installments on such assessments paid on or before ten (10) days after the date when due, as determined by the Board of Directors, shall not bear interest or an administrative late fee, but all sums not paid on or before ten (10) days after the date when due shall bear interest at the highest rate allowed by the laws of the State of Florida, as same may be amended from time to time, from the date when due until paid, and may be charged an administrative late fee as determined by the Board of Directors not to exceed the highest rate permitted by the laws of the State of Florida, as same may be amended from time to time. All payments upon account shall be first applied to interest and any administrative late fees, then to any attorney's fees and costs incurred in the collection of any past due assessment, and then to the assessment payment first due.
