## AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS OF RAINBERRY PARK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

(additions indicated by underlining, deletions by "----", and unaffected language by ". . . ")

Section 10.

Fining.

In addition to the means for enforcement provided elsewhere herein, and pursuant to Florida Statutes, as they may be amended from time to time, the Association shall have the power to impose fines against a Homeowner and/or Homeowner's guests, relatives or lessees. This remedy shall be cumulative to other remedies available to the Association under the governing documents and nothing herein shall be construed as a prohibition of or a limitation on the right of the Board of Directors to pursue other means to enforce the provisions of the various Association's documents including, but not limited to, legal action for damages or injunctive relief.
