The Recreation Area Board

The Rainberry Recreation ('Rec') Area Governing Board oversees the community's common area grounds and amenities as follows:

- The Association's Entrance
- The Parking Lots
- The Guards and Guard booth
- The Gates
- The Tennis and Basketball Courts
- The Main Pool

The Lake Board

The Lake Board manages all issues for Rainberry Lake and oversees the following:

- The Boat Gate at the North end of the lake
- Maintaining Lake Gate
- Suppling Lake Gate Remotes
- Removing/Sraying weeds along the shore line
- Fish Restocking

New residents can obtain a private gate remote from a member of the lake board. You will be able to access Lake Ida, Lake Eden, the E-4 Canal and Lake Osbourne. The current size limit is 8 feet wide by 18 feet long.
